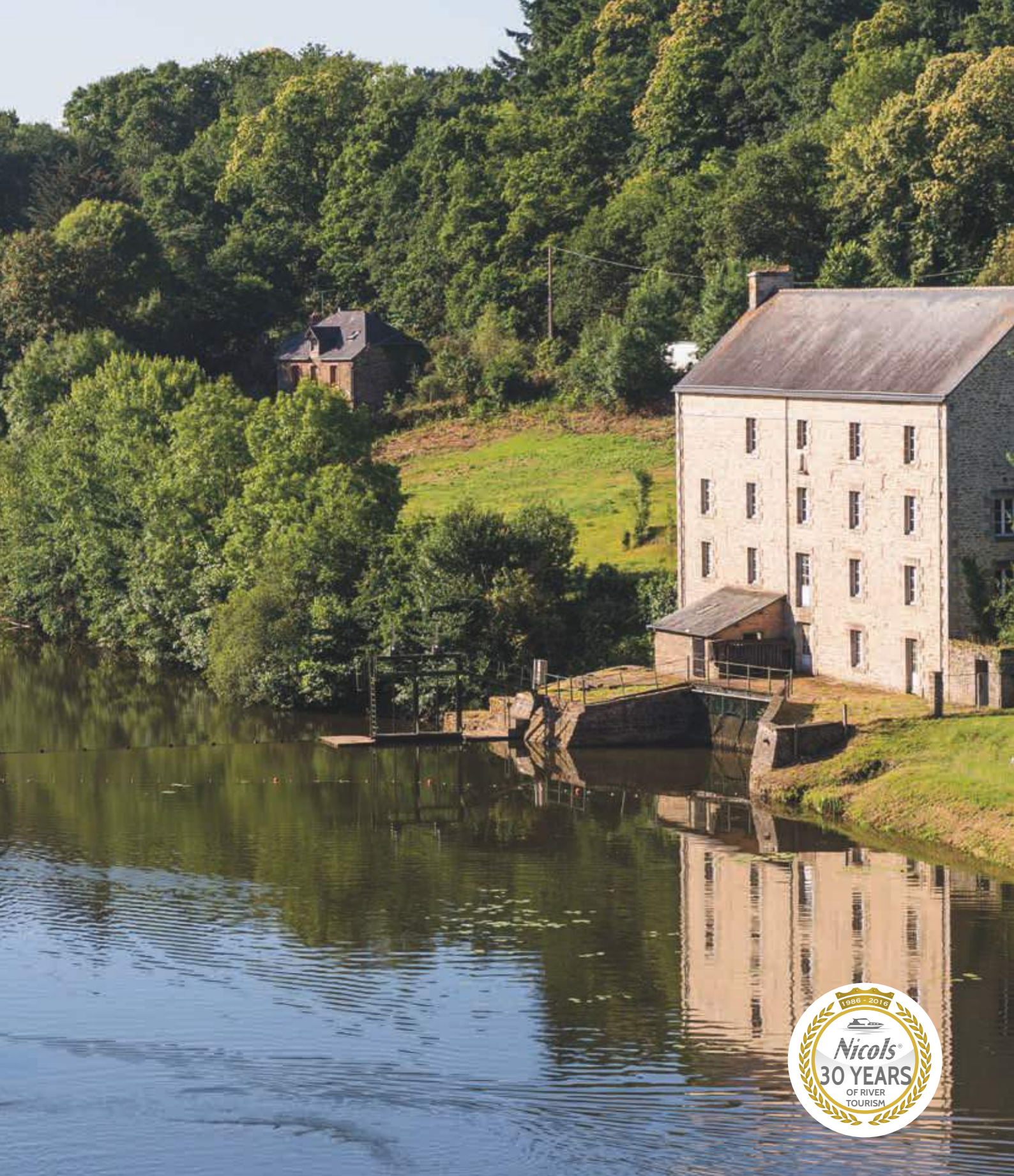

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## Get ready for your cruise and... enjoy the water

### ▶ Navigation is easy!

Our boats are easy to operate with either just one inside steering position or a second rooftop position to navigate under the sun with a panoramic view.

You will discover **simple controls that are easy to use**: the wheel, a gear lever and a few instruments on the dashboard. Don't worry if you've never been on a boat before - we'll show you everything you need to know before you set off. You'll be taken out on the water and given a hands on demonstration of everything from how to go through locks to tying up at the water's edge.

**Warning:** the minimum age to take the helm of a boat is 16 years old but they must remain under the captain's (an adult!) responsibility.

### ▶ Where to stop

During your cruise you're free to stop wherever you like...being careful not to disrupt the countryside and wildlife (or encroach on private property!) simply moor up and step ashore.

Day-by-day you'll discover new surroundings and sights as you travel at your own pace through beautiful countryside - a wonderful way to enjoy ever-changing scenery and the great outdoors.

If on the other hand you prefer the hustle and bustle of the towns and villages you pass on route then take advantage of the purpose-built ports and mooring sites. Some are free while others are available at a small charge (this varies depending on the size of the boat and whether there are power charging points). We estimate charges to be between 10€ to 50€. These comfortable and serviced areas will provide easy access to the town.

## ▶ LOCKS

- **Will I have to pay?** Passage through locks and bridges is free
- **Are they automatic?** Most locks are automatic and operated by a lock keeper who may ask you to help them, whilst others are manual. In the Charente the locks are all operated by you and your crew, thus you are not restricted by timetables.
- **Are there days of closing?** Most locks are automatic and operated by a lock keeper who will be happy to help you. In general, lock keepers do not work on Bank Holidays : **1<sup>st</sup> May, 14<sup>th</sup> July, 1<sup>st</sup> November.** For a list of regions concerned please contact us.



## ▶ Canal or river?

Most of the waterways in our brochure are generally wide and non-tidal making them easy to navigate. Depending on your chosen departure base you may cruise on both canals and rivers.

**Rivers, where natural**, are more susceptible to the possibility of flooding compared to **the manmade canals** - especially in Spring and Autumn.

Some navigation restrictions may occur as a result of this flooding and for your own safety we may change your departure base or restrict cruising to the canal sections only, rather than cancelling your cruise completely. Please make enquiries about the state of the waterways before leaving on your cruise.

## ▶ Waterways guides

A comprehensive guide is vital for planning your cruise. It provides detailed information of the waterways on which you will navigate highlighting **useful information** such as the location of locks, quays, water fill-up points in addition to **tourist information** such as places to visit and their opening hours, market days, good restaurants and much more.

We recommend you order your waterways guide at the same time as booking so that you receive it with the other cruise documentation you will be sent. This means you will have plenty of time to plan your journey in advance.



## Even more to enjoy...



### ▶ Bicycles

Bikes are available to hire from all of our bases and provide extra flexibility for exploring the area where you've moored, little villages, places of interest or simply for going to buy your daily bread.

*Helmets are recommended for children: please remember to bring your equipment.*



### ▶ Animals

Pets are welcome onboard. A supplement of 40 euros will be requested when you depart the base. Don't forget to bring their belongings (feeding bowl, bedding/blankets etc) and when travelling ensure that they remain safe and cannot cause any harm or damage.



### ▶ Fishing

Your boat is a great vantage point for fishing from. You can fish in the canals and rivers providing you hold a fishing licence.

These can be purchased from local fishing tackle shops or on the web ([www.cartedepeche.fr](http://www.cartedepeche.fr)).

In France: Cost approximately 30 euros and valid for 7 days.

In Portugal : about 25€ for your whole cruise



## ▶ Barbecue

Hire all of the equipment you'll need to enjoy a barbecue, then simply pick up your food fresh from the many mooring places you'll find on route.

Take it on board with you...most of our bases even offer rental of gas bottles. As with all barbecues please be careful and familiarise yourself with all the equipment before departure.



## ▶ WiFi

Whether it's your tablet, laptop or mobile phone... stay connected during your cruise!

Most of our bases offer a Wifi service that will allow you to connect multiple devices simultaneously\*. For more information please contact us.

(\*subject to the quality of network coverage. This varies by region).



## ▶ Your luggage

Holdalls are recommended - they are easy to stow away. Suitcases do take up far more space on board, so perhaps unpack them and leave in the boot of your car. Take with you comfortable non slip shoes so that you can move on the deck without danger (tennis or baskets).

Don't forget sun glasses and sun creams, hats, gloves... and your camera!

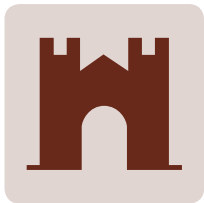

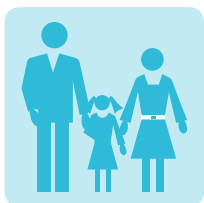

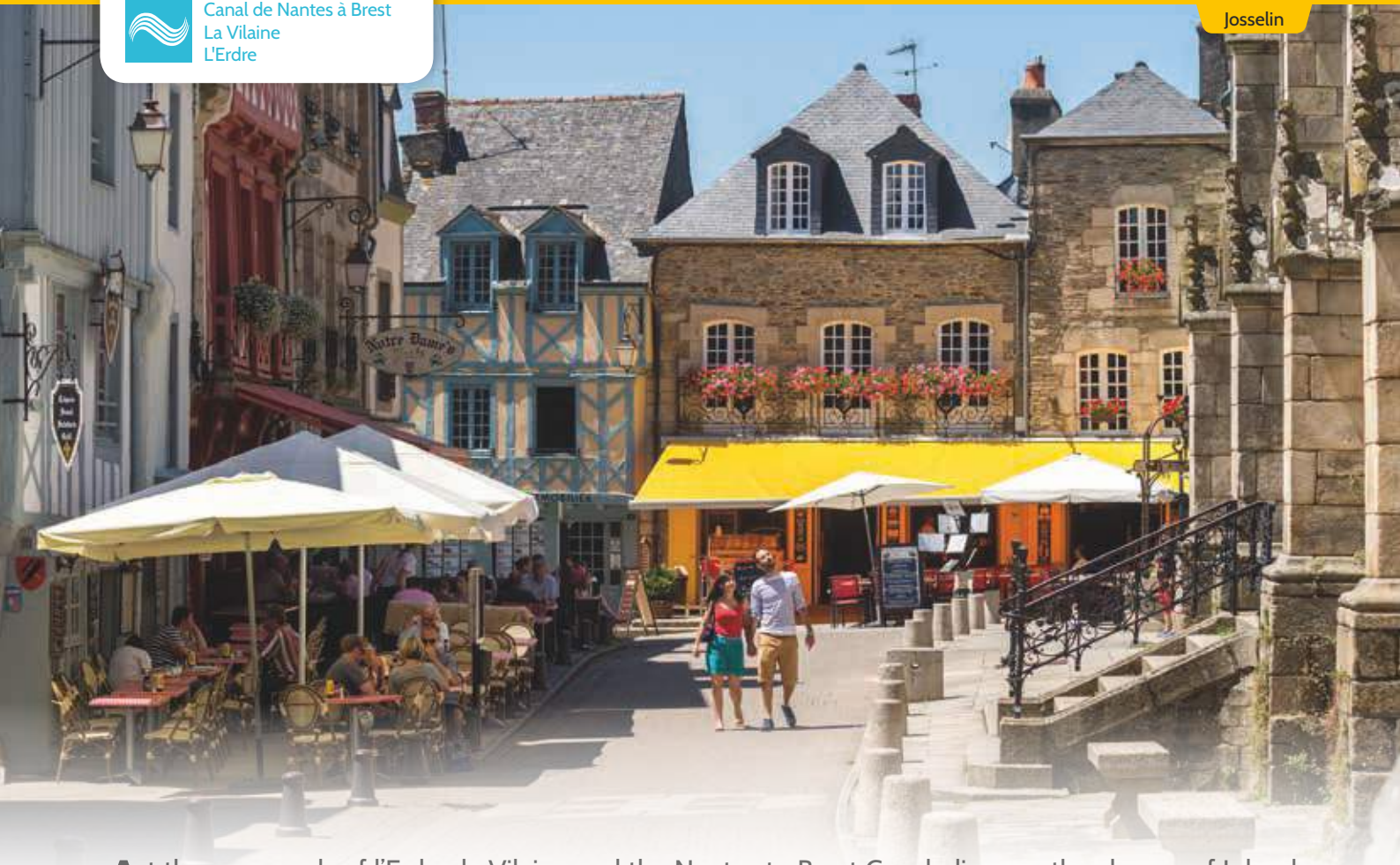

At the crossroads of l'Erdre, la Vilaine and the Nantes to Brest Canal, discover the charms of Inland Brittany: waterways devoted entirely to pleasure cruising, its traditions, its seafood, delicious crepes and traditional cider!



## From Glénac and Sucé-sur-Erdre

Explore a land of magic and mystery, rich in colour and traditions with a boating holiday in Brittany cruising the canal from Nantes to Brest. Enjoy historical treasures and remarkable natural sites: Josselin, with its magnificent castle reflected in the water ; **Malestroit and its 15<sup>th</sup> century houses** ; the craftsman village of Gacilly ; Redon founded in 832 or Blain (traditional popular arts museum).

The river Vilaine takes you to Rennes, the capital of Brittany, and on to Dinan and the surrounded ramparts dating back to the thirteenth century.

Following the Erdre you'll pass fantastic golf courses. Count **17 castles within just 15km of waterways on this stretch!** In two hours of locks free cruising you'll be at the heart of the city of Nantes and all its treasures: Cathedral St Pierre, Chateau des Ducs de Bretagne, Pommeraye passage, Museum of Fine Arts, the Machines of the Isle... to name just a few!

# Anjou

La Sarthe



Just a few hours from Paris, discover Anjou. Famous for its gentle atmosphere, excellent gastronomy, its castles and abbeys, rural stopover mooring points and sporting and cultural attractions! This region is also one of the best-equipped networks in France with plenty of mooring ports and easy to use locks with lockkeepers at hand. Here, waterways are entirely devoted to pleasure cruising. You will find relatively few locks (open all year round)... perfect for first time cruisers !



## From Grez-Neuville

Discover the river Mayenne, dotted with **small villages, manor houses, castles and old mills clinging** to the river's hillside. Make a stop at Angers, King René's city, also The Abbey of Port Salut in Entrammes (yes, the home of the famous cheese!). In the town of Laval the Naive Art Museum is worth visiting. The Oudon river near Grez-Neuville will bring you calmness and don't miss the stud farm in the Lion d'Angers.

## From Laval

See more with a one-way cruise from Laval to Sablé-sur-Sarthe or Laval to Grez-Neuville. This route is perfect for nature lovers taking in the high valleys of Anjou (a Natura 2000 nature protection area) with visits to great places such as Laval, Château Gonthier, Angers and Sablé-sur-Sarthe.

## From Sablé-sur-Sarthe

The river Sarthe is a **calm and peaceful river** meandering through verdant countryside dotted with picturesque villages. There are very few locks along its reaches, so it's ideal for beginners. Don't miss **the most elegant castle of plessis Bourré**, the imposing Benedictine Abbey of Solesmes, Malicorne, capital of artistic porcelain and the older part of Le Mans town.

The best bists : Locks operated by yourself so no restrictions on travel time ; Cognac and Pineau vineyards and tasting! Peaceful countryside and ancient Roman sites.



## From Sireuil

Large and winding, the river Charente quoted by François the 1<sup>st</sup> as "the most beautiful stream in the Kingdom", runs through the ancient counties of "Langoumois" and "La Saintonge".

For 171 km, from Angoulême to Rochefort, the Charente is regulated by 21 locks. The ancient vineyards cover the surrounding hills. Many cellars and distilleries will invite you to taste **the famous Cognac or delicious pineau des Charentes**. Along your cruise, you will find many villages and towns that are testimonies to a rich past such as Angoulême, Fleurac, Saint-Simeux, Châteauneuf, Saint-Simon, Bassac, Jarnac, Saint-Brice, Cognac, Saintes, Saint-Savinien, and Rochefort.

In the Charente area, the gastronomy based on seafood and local products, is waiting for you along the river with many of its restaurants preparing local specialities ("mouclade", oysters, melon, meats, snails, cheese...). Fishermen will not be forgotten and will find plenty of brown trout, carp, pike, perche, and eels...

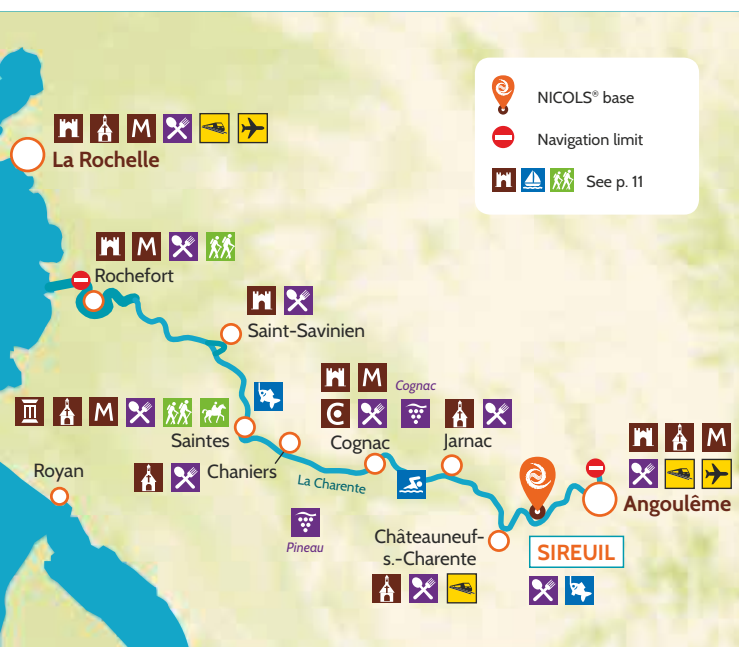

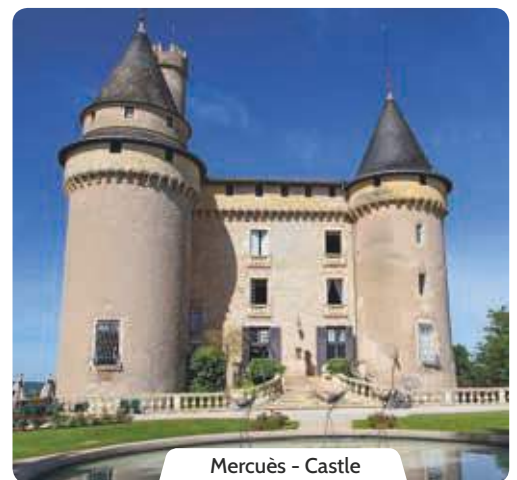

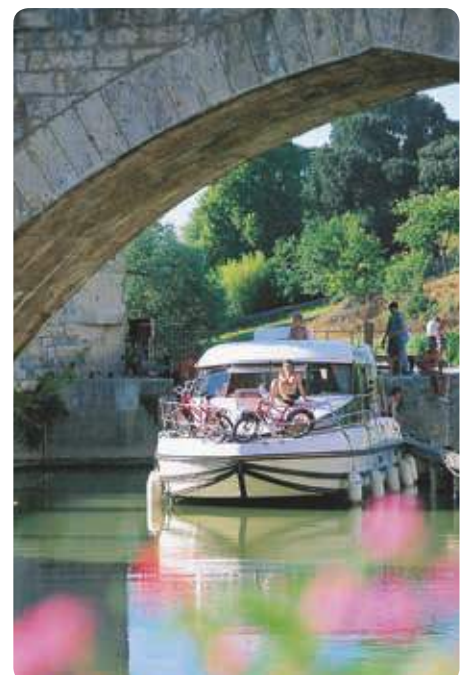
## Aquitaine, from Buzet

**Towards Bordeaux**, discover the Rembrandt of Le Mas d'Agenais, the promontory of Meilhan and the charming village of Fontet.





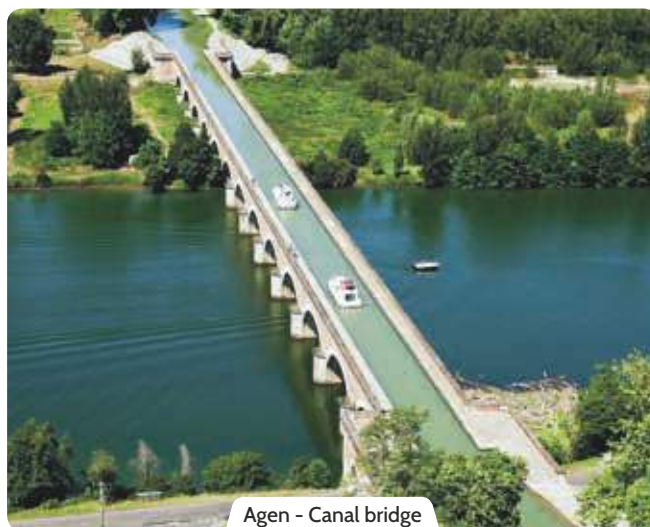

## From Le Somail

From the charming small port of Le Somail, cruise away to discover the Canal du Midi in the direction of **Carcassonne** or if your cruising time permits down to Narbonne close to the Mediterranean Sea. You will cruise on the largest pound of France (52 km without any locks) up to the Fonserannes staircase, situated close to the historical city of Béziers.

A few kilometres more and you arrive, via Agde, to the huge Etang de Thau - renowned for its oyster beds...

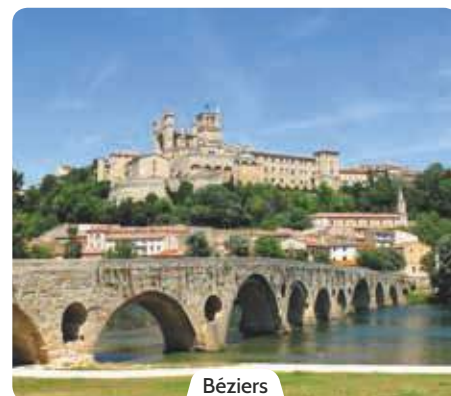
## From Port-Lauragais

Cast off from our new base in Port-Lauragais and sail west towards **Toulouse**, named the "pink city" because of its red brick buildings, rich with points of interest for tourists - Heritage Capitol museum, city of Space to name a couple.

To the East a must stop is **Castelnaudary** to try its delicious cassoulet, a local gastronomic specialty, before cruising on to the medieval city of Carcassonne. The streets of Trebes, whose origin date back to 4500BC, await you before reaching Homps and its man-made beaches.

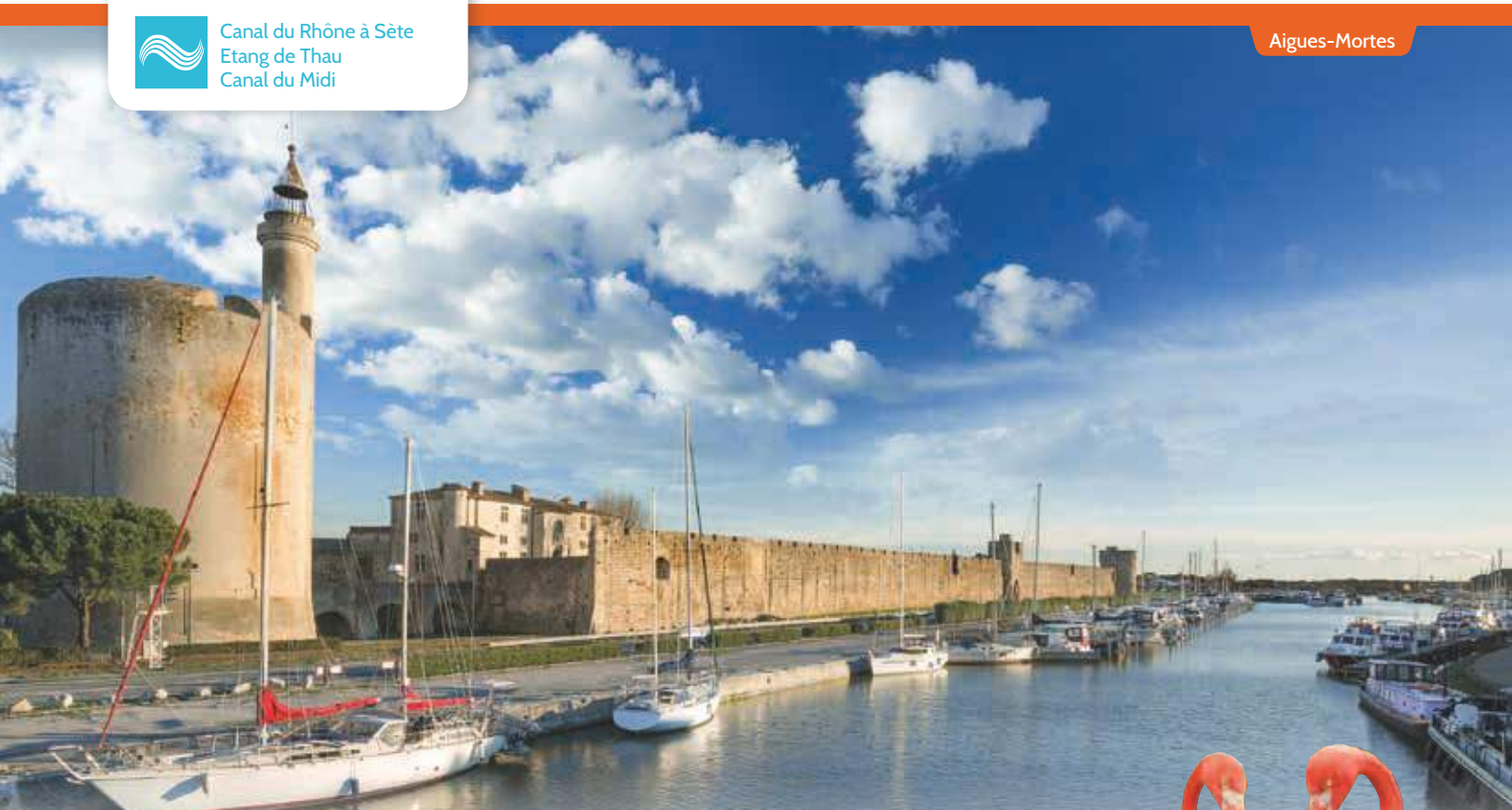

## From Bellegarde

Cruise away to discover the Etang de Thau and the Camargue, land of marshes, flamingos and wild horses.

**This formidable nature reserve of 85000 hectares** has the richest fauna and flora in Europe. Remarkable settings of fortified towns, remnants of past history dating to the first Crusades, Meridional foods, Bouzigues oysters, Costières de Nimes wines or Frontignan Muscat.

## From Aigues-Mortes

Visit Aigues Mortes, the fortified medieval town from the thirteenth century and starting point of the first crusades of King Louis IX, and the famous salt marshes that have surrounded the city since the Middle Ages. Elsewhere enjoy the Mediterranean beaches at Grau du Roi, Palavas-les-Flots, Grande Motte or in Carnon. See the Camargue's wild horses and bulls and an abundance of exceptional flora and fauna. Taste the oysters from Bouzigues, savor a glass of Picpoul or Frontignan Muscat; discover the treasures of the Abbey of Maguelone or Saint-Gilles by road to visit St Jacques de Compostela. Last but not least explore the city of Sète, a maritime town set at the opening of the Etang de Thau lagoon.

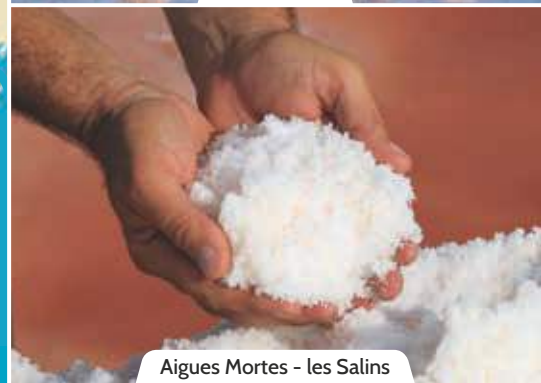

## From Rogny-les-Sept-Écluses and from Plagny

The Canal de Briare runs parallel to the Loire River and the superb Canal du Nivernais and offers peaceful waters alongside the rhythm of enchanting French village life. Set in surroundings between hills and forests the area is dotted with remarkable sites such as: Rogny with its seven locks built during the realm of Henry IV ; **the Briare canal bridge designed by Eiffel** ; Sancerre and pouilly, renowned for their world famous vineyards ; la Charité sur Loire (city of books) which is classified by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site and

an essential stop on the route to 'Saint-Jacques-de-Compostella' and Nevers, a town full of art, history and famous for its cathedral and gothic dukes' palace, its Roman church from the 11<sup>th</sup> century and some of the oldest potteries in France.

Lastly nature lovers should visit Bec d'Allier – the meeting point between Loire and Allier, one of the last wild rivers in Europe and classified a 'Panda Site' by the WWF.



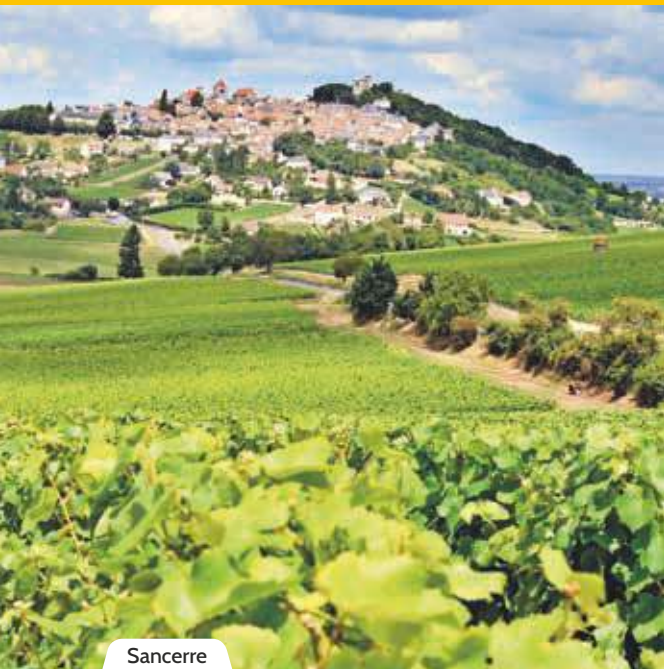

## From Briennon

Cliffs, groves, and waterside vineyards make up the landscape that surrounds the meandering rivers. Numerous castles, **medieval villages** and historic towns invite you to stop: Joigny, Sens, Auxerre (a city full of art and history) or Mailly-le-Château set on a rocky outcrop ...

The area is excellent for **fishing** with many species of fish populating the rivers including pike, carp, perch, bream and many more. **Climbers** can test their skills and practice climbing on the famous rocks at Saussois while wine lovers can visit cellars and **prestigious vineyards** (Châblis, Irancy, Crémant de Bourgogne...)



## From Venarey-les-Laumes

Cruising the Bourgogne canal is in itself a trip into the history of France whilst at the same time navigating one of the best known canals in the country. An exceptional number of sites and monuments border the canal. The most prestigious is incontestably **the Cistercian Abbey of Fontenay** (World Heritage of Unesco) but you will also discover a few paces away, or a short bicycle ride, imposing Burgundy castles such as Bussy, Tanlay, Ancy le Franc, Nuits, Maulne...

Prestigious world-renowned wines and excellent traditional Burgundy gastronomy await you at each bend of the canal. Our Venarey base also provides cruising itineraries to discover the Nivernais canal, and stop offs such as Auxerre with its gothic cathedral.



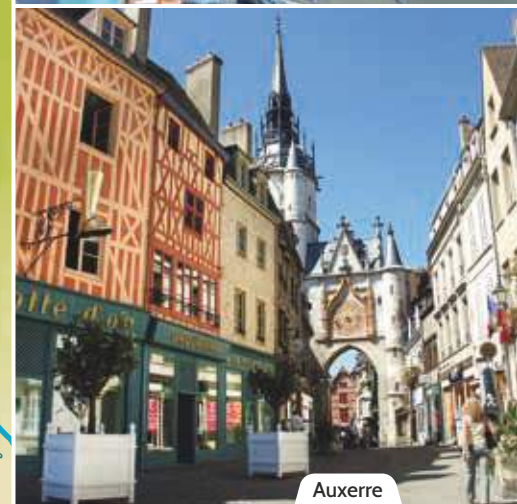

To make moving from one end of the boat to the other safe and easy all our walkways are covered with an antislipping surface, have a hand rail and a double railing\* at a height of 60 cm (safety criteria imposed by the legislation for boats made in France). The rear terrace on the Sedan and Estivale ranges are on the same level as the living room meaning there are no stairs to negotiate going either in or out of the boat. The front terrace of the Confort range can be reached via a gangway 1 metre high moulded into the hull deck for the maximum safety.



All these criteria mean that Nicols® boats are one of the safest on the market, particularly when it comes to accommodating crews with children and/or people with reduced mobility.

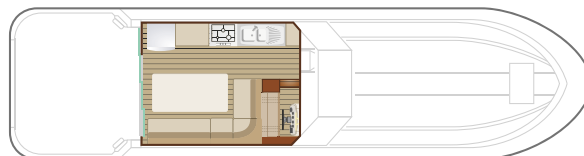
